

OPERATIONAL PROCEDURE FOR VISITATION-FCI JESUP, GEORGIA

Modified Visitation Procedures

- Visitors must be symptom screened and temperature checked upon entry into the facility. Visitors who are sick or symptomatic will not be allowed entry.
- Both inmates and visitors must wear face coverings at all times and perform hand hygiene before and after the visit. Visitors are expected to wear and will be screened for appropriate face coverings (including improper coverings such as bandanas.)
- **There will be no physical contact of any kind to include an embrace** at the beginning and end of the visit. Additionally, inmates and their visitors will not be authorized to take photographs based on the inability to socially distance themselves.
- Food and beverages will not be allowed. Special provisions must be made to allow for baby formula/food.
- To ensure physical distance during entry and exit of visitors a 15 minute processing period is maintained to halt cross contamination.
- If inmates or visitors make contact at any time, the visit will be terminated immediately and visitation privileges may be suspended.

Scheduling Visitation

- Inmates must identify two visitors in the request a child counts as a visitor. They may request a specific time but if the time slot is full, they will be assigned a time slot by their Unit team. The inmate will be notified of the new time slot by Unit team.
- It is the responsibility of the inmate to notify their visitors of the scheduled time and date of the visit.

FCI Jesup Visiting

- Visitation will be held at the FCI on Saturday, Sunday, Monday and Tuesday.
- Visitation hours of operation will be from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm

FSL Jesup Visiting

- Visitation will be held at the FSL on Saturday, Sunday and Monday.
- Visitation hours of operation will be from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm.

SPC Jesup Visiting

- Visitation will be held at the SPC on Saturday and Sunday.
- Visitation hours of operation will be from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm

Legal Visits:

An attorney visit for an inmate will be verified and coordinated by the Unit Team at least 24 hours in advance. If approved, the attorney will be permitted to visit during regularly scheduled visiting days and hours. Attorneys requesting visits with inmates on non-visiting days or after normal visiting hours will be accommodated as time, security, and manpower constraints permit, ordinarily with 24 hours advance notice.

Attorneys may be allowed to bring pertinent document into the visiting area but may not leave any documents with the inmate.

Attorneys will be required to provide proper identification prior to the visit. Proper identification will be a valid driver's license with photograph and a current Bar Association card to classify as an attorney legal visit.
