

# FCC LOMPOC BULLETIN Modified Visiting

Starting October 2, 2020, inmate social visits will resume at FCI Lompoc. On October 3, 2020, social visits will resume at the Camps and USP. In order for this to happen, the following procedures have been implemented to maintain a safe, secure, and sanitary environment, to preserve the health and safety of all inmates, staff and visitors.

## Visitor Coronavirus (COVID-19) Screening

- Prior to entrance into any facility at the Complex, visitors will be required to be screened for symptoms of Covid-19. Refusal to be screened will result in the visitor be denied visiting privileges for that day.
- The Screening Site will be located at the Scott Williams Training Center on Oakridge Road, directly across the street from the service entrance to the USP. Visitor screening hours will begin at 8:30 a.m. on Fridays (**visiting on Fridays is for FCI ONLY**), and 7:30 a.m. on Saturday, Sunday, and Holidays. Visitors are not authorized to park anywhere on FCC Lompoc's property prior to the opening of the visitor screening-site. Any visitor found on the property before authorized times, are subject to visiting privileges be denied for that day.
- The screening-site will be an outdoor, drive-thru screening-site, where visitors will be symptom screened and temperature checked in their cars. Visitors who appear sick or symptomatic will not be authorized to visit. Visitors will be screened for the following:
  - Temperature of > 100°
  - New-Onset Cough
  - New-Onset Trouble Speaking/Difficulty Breathing
  - Fatigue
  - Muscle or Body Aches
  - Sore Throat
  - New Loss of Taste or Smell
  - Stuffy/Runny Nose
  - Nausea or Vomiting
  - Diarrhea
  - Any other symptom classified by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)
- Screened visitors approved for access into the facility will be issued a color-coded wristband, to validate they have been screened.
- Masks **WILL BE REQUIRED** throughout the process. Visitors without masks or masks deemed inappropriate or vulgar will not be permitted to visit.

There is **zero tolerance** for violations of unauthorized physical contact.

## Visiting for Inmates and Visitors

- Visitor screening will be in compliance with established policies and local procedures in addition to the following:
- Visiting will initiate at 9:00 a.m. on Fridays (**visiting on Friday is for FCI ONLY**) and 8:00 a.m. Saturday, Sunday, and Holidays. Visiting hours will end at 3:00 p.m., with no visitors permitted entrance after 2:00 p.m.
- Visitors will wait in an orderly fashion, inside and outside of the front lobby, to maintain social distancing and reduce overcrowding.
- Visitors will be processed in on a first-come, first-serve basis, based on the housing unit conducting visiting that day.
- A maximum of two screened cohort groups are allowed to be awaiting escort, in the outside area past screening (as indicated by ground markings).
- Visitors must wear wristbands appropriately displayed on wrist at all times during their visit and entry into any facility at the Complex.
- Visitors will be visually checked to ensure they are wearing the correct colored wristband and an appropriate mask.
- Visitors are required to perform hand hygiene – wash hands at the screening site (Front Lobby areas) or use hand sanitizer -- just before and after the visit.
- Inmate visiting will be conducted by cohort units, on a rotating schedule. Schedules will be posted in the housing units, on TRULINCs and the main institution phone line.
- All inmates are required to be in proper uniform and wear their issued facial covering and perform hand hygiene – wash hands in the search area or use hand sanitizer -- just before and after the visit.
- Photographs are not authorized based on the inability to socially distance.
- Food and beverages will not be allowed during visiting hours.
- Visitation will be non-contact only. There will be no physical contact of any kind to include an embrace at the beginning and end of the visit. There will be **zero tolerance** for violations of unauthorized physical contact.
- Tables will serve as barriers between inmate and visitors to prevent any contact. Tables will be marked with reminders to ensure visitors and inmates understand unauthorized contact will result in termination of visiting.
- For social distancing purposes, only two (2) seat-requiring visitors and two (2) small children will be permitted at a time. Small children will be considered children that can be appropriately seated on a visitor's lap. Visitor will maintain constant supervision of their children during visiting. Children large enough to occupy a seat will be considered an adult visitor for social distancing purposes.
- Visitors will check-in with the Correctional Officer inside the visiting room where they will be notified of the current time, and when the visiting period expires. Visits will only be permitted for one hour, from the time both the inmate and visitor are in each other's

presence as long as visiting capacity is full. **When the visiting room has reached established social distancing capacity**, visits will be terminated as, needed, by check-in time with the officer, i.e., first in, first out.

- Social distancing (6 feet apart) between visitors and inmates will be enforced and closely monitored.
- Coordinated entry and exit of visitors will be conducted by a Correctional Officer to ensure social distancing is maintained.
- Visitors not adhering to protocols will be immediately addressed and if behavior continues, may have their visit terminated.
- Inmates in quarantine or isolation will not participate in social visiting.
- Special Housing Unit (SHU): Special Housing Unit visiting will remain intact (video visits). Visitors will screen in and report to the Camp South visiting area where they will check in with the Camp South Visiting Officer. SHU visits will occur one at a time for no more than one hour.

There is **zero tolerance** for violations of unauthorized physical contact.
